Good Shepherd Uniform Requirements

January 2023

The new active uniform was designed following consultation with students, parents and staff, and reflects their feedback. It is an external representation of the pride and connection that we have in our school.

We believe the uniform:

- Is smart, comfortable and practical.
- Enables students to be active learners.
- Is gender inclusive and supports freedom of movement and equal opportunities for all students.
- Represents cost saving and value for money as the number of items have been consolidated and the same uniform can be worn.

We acknowledge that individual students have differing needs, as such our uniform provides options to cater for these needs.

The school uniform is an active uniform and is worn during all terms of the school year. The new uniform consists of:

- Short sleeve polo
- Long sleeve polo
- Soft shell jacket
- Shorts
- Skort
- Track suit pants
- Bucket hat
- Sports socks
- Special long sleeve seniors garment (year 6 only)

The new active uniform is consolidated and reduces the number of items required. The items are interchangeable and can be worn in several ways: i.e. shorts/skort with long/short sleeve polo or track suit pants with long/short sleeve polo.

Other items of uniform

Shoes

- Black sports shoes, lace up style or velcro (no skate or street shoes)

Vest

- The tri-core vest is an optional item which can be layered with other uniform items to suit changing weather conditions.

School bag

- School bags with the school logo are an optional item and are available from the uniform shop.

Hair, make-up, and jewelry expectations

Hair

- Hair for all students must be neat and well – groomed at all times.
- A ribbon or scrunchie in school colours (navy, maroon, or sky blue) may be worn.
- Hair should be natural colour. Highlights within the natural colour range are acceptable.

Make-up

- Students are not permitted to wear make-up (including nail polish).

Jewelry

- A watch of reasonable size may be worn.
- A small, simple cross may be worn (no other religious artifacts or medallions).
- Medical alert bracelets can be worn.
- A maximum of one plain gold/silver sleeper in each lobe.
- No other jewelry may be worn. This includes rings, bracelets, bangles and bands.

Good Shepherd pre-2023 sports uniform (old uniform)

- The old Good Shepherd sports uniform may be worn up to, and including, December 2024. This is the transition period of the new active uniform.
- As with the 2023 active uniform, the old Good Shepherd sports uniform is consolidated and interchangeable and can be worn in a number of different ways: i.e shorts/skort with short/long sleeve polo or track pants with short/long sleeve polo.
- The Good Shepherd formal uniform may not be worn after December 2022.
- All students will wear the Good Shepherd active uniform from January 2025.

Cross contamination

- During the two-year transition period students may choose to wear *either* the old Good Shepherd sports uniform or the new Good Shepherd active uniform.
- Mixing and matching of old and new uniform is not permitted. The one exception to this is Year 6 students may wear the special seniors garment with the old sports uniform or the new active uniform.

At all times students are ambassadors of Good Shepherd and are expected to wear the uniform in a way that reflects their pride in the school.

In accepting enrolment families are stating their intention to comply with the uniform requirements.
